The Onondaga County Clerk's Office, to ensure its compliance with NYS RP Law §334 (2-a), is implementing the following policy for the electronic submission of survey and subdivision maps:

- 1. All subdivision maps that are going to be submitted electronically FIRST MUST meet all applicable requirements for filing approved subdivision maps listed on the Onondaga County Planning Agency website.
- 2. Filers are encouraged to electronically submit their maps. Electronically submitted copies will always be crisper and clearer than images created by scanning a hard copy.
- 3. While the electronically submission of maps in Onondaga County is consensual at this point, we reserve the right in the future to institute a policy of mandatory electronic submissions under the authority granted in NYS RP Law § 334.
- 4. The electronically submission of maps can be done through one of the approved erecording vendors that are already used for the e-recording of land records. For more information on e-recording or approved vendors, visit the Onondaga County Clerk's website.
- 5. Maps can be either a PDF-A or TIFF format for electronic submission.
- 6. Maps can be in black and white, greyscale, or CMYK color format for electronic submission. Please bear in mind that higher resolution will mean slower upload and download times.
- 7. Maps must be in a minimum 300 dpi/ppi and maximum of 600 dpi/ppi. Please bear in mind that higher resolution will mean slower upload and download times.
- 8. Must have a tag embedded in the code of the file properties so that printing of the map will result in printing to original size and scale.
- 9. Fee: \$10.00.
