Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – County Executive McMahon today announced that the applications for the Onondaga County Agritourism Grant Program are now available. Ensuring that we embrace and make strategic investments in our agricultural community is one of five main components in the recently adopted County Comprehensive Plan, Plan Onondaga. Agritourism, in particular, is an area that is prime for investment and growth.
