Onondaga County Agriculture Council Kicks Off Fourth Year of "Buy Local. Buy Onondaga Grown." Campaign

Announces Date of Third Annual ONFarm Fest

SYRACUSE, N.Y. - Onondaga County Executive Joanie Mahoney and the Onondaga County Agriculture Council today launched year four of the "Buy Local. Buy Onondaga Grown" campaign to encourage the community to purchase food products grown in Onondaga County.

A kickoff event was held at the Tre-G Farm in Pompey and allowed those in attendance to enjoy a taste of locally grown and produced foods. County Executive Mahoney, New York State Senator Dave Valesky, Executive Director of Cornell Cooperative Extension of Onondaga County David Skeval, and Agriculture Council Co-Chairs - County Legislator David Knapp and farmer Harvey Skeele, spoke about the many benefits of seeking out locally grown products.

The "Buy Local. Buy Onondaga Grown" campaign, which seeks to educate the public on the importance of farming and farmland to our community, runs now through October. During the campaign, the community will learn about the size and scope of Onondaga County's agricultural industries such as produce, dairy, meat, maple and honey products, and more. They will also learn the value of farmland and the importance of preserving it for generations to come. The community is also encouraged to select Onondaga Grown items by looking for the Onondaga Grown logo at local grocers, convenience stores, farm stands, farmers markets, and restaurants.

"We are fortunate to have a robust and diverse agricultural industry in our county," said Onondaga County Executive Joanie Mahoney. "When you choose Onondaga Grown products you are not only supporting local farmers, but you are also providing your family with the most nutritious and delicious seasonal products available."

"The Agriculture Council is excited to continue the Onondaga Grown campaign to promote and support our local agriculture," said Harvey Skeele, Onondaga County Farmer and Agriculture Council Co-Chair.

David Knapp, Onondaga County Legislator and Agriculture Council Co-Chair said, "We are pleased to announce that the third annual ON Farm Fest day-on-the-farm event will be held on September 22nd. We were thrilled with the turnout for last year's event and hope to build on that by adding more farms to the tour this year. We will share more details as they become available, but we hope that you will plan to spend a family-friendly day touring some of our local farms."
