PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE FOR APULIA ROAD CULVERT PROJECT

The Onondaga County Department of Transportation will hold a Public Information Meeting to discuss improvements to the Apulia Road over Rush Creek in the Town of DeWitt. The meeting will begin at 6:00 P.M. on Thursday, January 3, 2019 at:

After a brief presentation, engineers will be available at project stations (open house format), offering a welcoming environment for the public to review preliminary plans, ask questions, and provide comments and concerns.

The proposed project is located on Apulia Road (C.R. 2) approximately 900 feet southerly of NYS Route 173 in the hamlet of Jamesville. The existing concrete structure has a low condition rating based on the Onondaga County Department of Transportation's biannual inspection. The structure will be replaced with a precast concrete box culvert. An upgraded guiderail system will be installed. This project is scheduled for construction in 2019.

This project is a locally administered state aid project. It is being progressed by Onondaga County, with involvement from the New York State Department of Transportation.
