**PUBLIC INFORMATION WEB SITE NOTICE FOR
BUCKLEY ROAD (C.R. No. 48) RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

The Onondaga County Department of Transportation will host a Public Information Web Site to present the proposed reconstruction of the Buckley Road Reconstruction Project in the Towns of Salina and Clay from Friday, March 1, 2024 through Friday, March 22, 2024. To access the Web Site go to:

A detailed overview of the project, along with a question and comment tab will be available at the web site. Representatives from the Onondaga County Department of Transportation and the design consultant will answer questions from interested parties, and will obtain comments and input for final design.

The proposed project is on Buckley Road, beginning approximately 300 feet south of the Hopkins Road intersection the Town of Salina and ends south of the West Taft Road intersection in the Town of Clay. The Onondaga County Department of Transportation is addressing safety deficiencies, improving capacity, providing accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists, addressing drainage deficiencies, and preserving the pavement of Buckley Road. The project includes pavement widening for the addition of a two-way left turn lane at the Dolshire intersection, to reduce collisions, and the additions of a sidewalk and a shared use travel lane to improve accessibility for pedestrians and bicyclists. This project is scheduled for construction in 2025.

This project is a locally administered Federal aid project. It is being progressed by Onondaga County Department of Transportation in coordination with the New York State Department of Transportation. Presently, the project is in the preliminary design phase.
