MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Successful Completion of Traineeship requirements; or,

Possession of a Class A or Class B Commercial driver license (CDL) with appropriate endorsements as required by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles for the class of vehicle being operated. Eligibility for and continued possession of the license is required for employment.

WORK ACTIVITIES

Operates heavy dump trucks with front plow, wing plow(s) and aggregate spreader to plow snow and control ice simultaneously. Operates tractor mounted mowers to control grass and weed growth within the highway right-of-way. Performs physical labor tasks as required. Washes or steam cleans trucks and other equipment. Responsible for written or computed daily work logs including route/location logs and material logs. Acts as an essential personnel and required to respond to emergency call-ins.
