**PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING NOTICE FOR BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT ON MARIETTA
MARCELLUS ROAD, CR#83, OVER NINEMILE CREEK**

The Onondaga County Department of Transportation will hold a Public Information Meeting to discuss the rehabilitation to County Bridge C-229 over Ninemile Creek in the Town of Marcellus. The meeting will begin at 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at:

After a brief presentation, engineers will be available at project stations (open house format), offering a welcoming environment for the public to review preliminary plans, ask questions, and provide comments and concerns.

The proposed project is located on Marietta Marcellus Road (C.R. 83- South Street) over Ninemile Creek. This federally funded bridge project is considered element specific maintenance (minor) and includes replacing the bridge expansion joints and replacing the waterproof membrane that protects the bridge deck. It is anticipated that the work will take place during the 2019 construction season.

This project is a federally funded project. It is being progressed by Onondaga County, with involvement from the New York State Department of Transportation.
