PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING FOR OLD ROUTE 57 PAVING PROJECT

The Onondaga County Department of Transportation will hold a Public Information Meeting to discuss roadway improvements to Old Route 57 (Oswego Road) in the Town of Clay. The meeting will begin at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, September 27, 2017 at the Liverpool High School 9th Grade Annex Cafeteria, 4340 Wetzel Road, Liverpool.

After a brief presentation, engineers will be available at project stations (open house format), offering a welcoming environment for the public to review preliminary plans, ask questions, and provide feedback.

The proposed project begins at the intersection of Route 57 and Blackberry Road, and proceeds northerly for approximately 1.4 miles to the intersection with Pine Hollow Drive. This is primarily a resurfacing project, with the corridor being milled and paved. As part of the work, traffic signals, pedestrian signals, shoulders, drainage, striping and signage will be improved. This project is currently in the preliminary design phase and is scheduled to begin during the 2019 construction season.

This project is a locally administered federal aid project. It is being progressed by Onondaga County, with involvement from the New York State Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration.
