School Age Teenage Parents – TAP Program

To be eligible for the TAP program you must meet and complete the following requirements / procedures / conditions:

- You may choose a Day Care Center, a Registered Group or Family Day Care Provider, (they are licensed by the State of New York) or a Legally Exempt (Informal) Provider. If you need assistance finding a Day Care Provider – Contact Child Care Solutions at (315) 446-1220.
- You must submit a copy of your current school schedule, attendance, and report card – signed by your school representative. (Form Attached)
- You must remain a student in good standing – maintaining a minimum of 75% attendance.
- Your grades will be monitored for satisfactory progress.
- You may be approved only **ONCE** during a school year. If your Day Care closes because you are **NOT** a student in good standing or making satisfactory progress, you will not be eligible for a subsidy again during the balance of the current school year.
- You must sign the acknowledgement below that you understand and agree to these requirements.
