MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZED MILITIA OR RESERVES

NYS Military Law Section 243-b (2)

Any member of the organized militia or reserves who, because of active military duty other than for training purposes, missed the application filing period for an examination and as a result is deprived of the opportunity to compete in an examination, shall be given a special military make-up examination. The make-up examination will be administered under the terms and conditions set by the Onondaga County Department of Personnel.

NYS Military Law Section 243-b (3)

Any member of the organized militia or reserves who, because of active military duty other than for training purposes, missed the application deadline for a scheduled examination and who returns from such duty *prior* to the administration of such examination shall be granted a waiver of the application requirement and allowed to compete in the examination. The examination may be administered on an alternate test date.

Candidates who are entitled to take an examination under these provisions must:

- Submit a copy of military orders, DD 214 or other military documentation that substantiates his/her military service at the time of the application filing deadline or examination
- Meet the minimum qualifications required of all other candidates for the examination
- Meet all other terms and conditions required by law and rule
