ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMITTEE MINUTES – DECEMBER 11, 2023 JULIE ABBOTT, CHAIR

MEMBERS PRESENT: Ms. Cody, Ms. Kuhn, Mr. McCarron, Mr. Garland

Chair Abbott called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m. and the previous meeting's minutes were approved.

- 1. WATER ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION: Shannon Harty, Commissioner
 - a. A Resolution Calling a Public Hearing in Connection with Proposed Improvements for the Onondaga County Sanitary District (February 6, 2024 at 12:55 p.m.)
- Upon approval, project resolutions will be submitted for January Committee
- Anticipating 5 key projects totaling \$56M
 - o \$25M to finish rehab of Camillus force main
 - o \$9.5M West Entry Pump Station upgrade (Baldwinsville Seneca Knolls Service area)
 - o \$19M White Pine Rt. 31 sewer expansion (\$16M previously authorized for total of \$35M)
 - o \$500k for miscellaneous asset renewal
 - o \$1.8M miscellaneous engineering

Questions/Comments from the Committee:

- Will anything be bonded?
 - o Yes; all have bond resolutions associated with them
 - o Funding information will be provided at the January Committee meeting

Law Department

- Correction in 2nd Whereas Clause; letter e.
 - o Should read "White Pine/Route 31 Sewer Expansion \$19,000,000"

A motion was made by Mr. McCarron, seconded by Ms. Kuhn, to approve this item. Passed unanimously; MOTION CARRIED.

- b. Authorizing the Acquisition of Real Property in the Town of Clay for Sewer Purposes (\$216,000)
- Construction of new pump station and force mains to expand sewer services into Rt. 31/Caughdenoy intersection
 - o Land being acquired by OCIDA
 - o 2nd part of project is constructing 2 force mains that will connect to Oak Orchard WWTP; 3.6 mile route
 - o 80% of route will be in public right of ways along Caughdenoy Rd., Van Hosen Rd., and Verplank Rd.
- Negotiating with property owners between Caughdenoy Rd. and Van Hosen Rd.
- Working with National Grid and CSX Railroad
- Purchasing vacant 8.45 acre lot north of Rt. 31 for \$216k; no structures on property

Questions/Comments from the Committee:

• Is there a signed contract with Micron yet?

Law Department

- o There is a signed term sheet with general terms and conditions for funding sources
- Not aware of an actual contract

o SEQRA will be done shortly

WEP

- o WEP is seeking investment for infrastructure that will be shared and beneficial for entire area
- o Micron will be using a portion of the new infrastructure

A motion was made by Ms. Cody, seconded by Mr. Garland, to approve this item. Passed unanimously; MOTION CARRIED.
