A Certificate of Residence cannot be issued any earlier than 60 days prior to the start of the semester or 3 days after, in accordance with SUNY and New York State regulations.		
A minimum of two forms of supporting documentation is required to accompany the original, notarized form. One (1) document must be dated at least a year prior to the application date placing the student in New York State and a second (2) dated within the month prior to the application date placing the student in Onondaga County. If the student has moved in the last year, proof of each address within the previous six months is required.
