IMPORTANT NOTICE!

This form must be completed and returned with a copy of the **Veteran’s Military Separation Record** (DD214, WDAGO55, WDAGO 53-55, NAVPERS 553, NAVHC 78 or WDAGO 53), as well as **Proof of Residency** (copy of valid NYS drivers license).

Eligibility: Only those Veterans who have had an honorable discharge, who served within the applicable war dates listed below, but were NOT residents of Onondaga County at the time of entry into the service. The Veteran must be a current resident of Onondaga County, and have lived in Onondaga County for a minimum of 10 years to be eligible.
